WHAT'S DIFFERENT ABOUT THE GO DIVE IDC?

Quality:

Unlike many IDCs Go Dive limits its IDC student numbers, we only take a maximum of eight candidates per course with a minimum of two staff members (ratio of 4-1; allowed ratio is 16-2 following IDC standards).

Smaller numbers means we can spend more time preparing you to be an excellent instructor; we maximize our pool and open water time and minimize the time spent in the classroom.

In addition our IDC is conducted over 10 days making the experience easier on you and giving you time to prepare for your sessions.

Flexibility:

Because the IDC at Go Dive includes the PADI e-learning option, you can start your IDC anytime and take your time to complete the online modules.

You can complete the Assistant Instructor part of the Instructor Course on our AI Internship Program before the next planned full IDC. As a PADI Assistant Instructor you can:

Experience:

HOW IS THE PADI IDC STRUCTURED?

The PADI IDC is made up of the PADI Assistant Instructor (AI) Course and the PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor Course (OWSI).

The AI course is four days long and we build upon your abilities to organize and supervise scuba diving activities, while concentrating on developing teaching skills.

The OWSI course is six days long and introduces you to the entire PADI System of diver education and concentrates on further developing your abilities as a professional dive educator.

The OWSI course is usually followed by a PADI Instructor Exam (IE) which independently tests your readiness to be a PADI Instructor.

WHAT ARE THE PRE-REQUISITES FOR ATTENDING THE COURSES?

To attend the AI Course you must:

-) Be a PADI Divemaster or have a qualifying certification from another certification organization (to attend the AI Internship Program you must be an active status (insured) PADI Divemaster).
-) Be at least 18 years old
-) Have 60 logged dives, including night, deep, and navigation dives
-) Have been a certified diver for at least 6 months
-) Have CPR and First Aid Training within the last 24 months
-) Be fit for diving and submit a Medical Statement (PDF) signed by a physician within the last 12 months
-) Want a fun and exciting career!

To attend the OWSI Course you must:

-) Be certified as a PADI Divemaster, PADI Assistant Instructor or be an instructor in good standing with another training organization for at least six months
-) Meet all the requirements for the AI Course

To attend a PADI IE you must:

-) Successfully complete a PADI IDC or OWSI program within the last 12 months
-) Have 100 logged dives.

To qualify as a PADI Instructor you must:

-)] Successfully complete the IE
-)] Be an Emergency First Response Instructor or have a qualifying equivalent rating.
-)] Hold liability insurance for dive instruction.
